Recently, Susanne published a gorgeous book: *A Closer Look | The Neighborhood*. It is 68 pages of beautiful photography of nature and original writing.

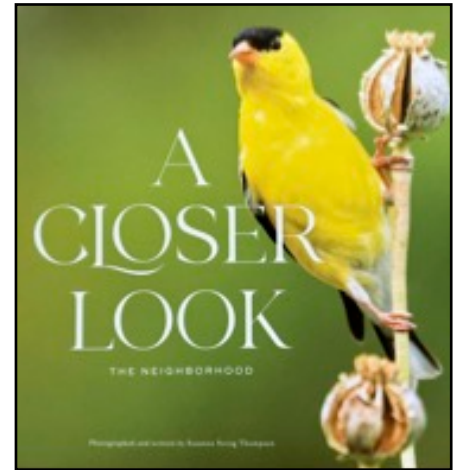
As readers turn the pages, they experience a sense of wonder and are encouraged to slow down to see the beauty that we often miss.

As a book photographed and written about experiencing nature in an Atlanta neighborhood, it is a perfect local story, but with broad appeal to everyone in Georgia. The photographs are mostly tight shots, so it doesn't look "neighborhood specific."

In this era of constant tension, how can we catch our breath to face the day? *A Closer Look | The Neighborhood* presents an idea as how to experience a moment of calm while finding wonder in seeing the nature that is right there but that we often overlook.

*A Closer Look | The Neighborhood* was not only created locally through photographs in one Atlanta neighborhood and writing that is reflective of those nature experiences. It also was printed and designed right here in town.
